We are so excited that you'll be at camp June 22, 23 & 24!

Camp starts **Friday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> at 10am**. Show up at camp at 10am! Camp ends with worship at the outdoor worship center at 11:30am on June 24, and lunch with your family.

**Parents! It is very important that you arrive on time, but please do not arrive before 10am.** As a camp staff, we have lots to do before camp starts and will be working right up until 10am. **We won't be ready to check anyone in until 10am.** Check in will be to the right as you drive through Central Christian Camp's gate at Rainbow Lodge. We should be easy to spot!

**We will be ending camp with worship at 11:30am.** We ask that parents/guardians join us as we celebrate the end of our time together and have communion together for the first time. Communion will be optional and will be left up to the parents/guardians to decide if their child will participate. After worship we will have a picnic lunch. Parents and family of the camper are invited to stay for lunch. *Please give us your reservations Friday when you drop off your camper.*

Make sure to bring a water bottle marked with your name, something easy to carry around with you. It will be hot and we want you to stay hydrated!

Attached you will find a complete list of what to bring to camp and some things NOT to bring to camp. You may bring money for offering on Sunday but no other money will be needed at camp.

If you have **medicine** that you take daily, bring it in a Zip Lock bag with your name on it and when you are supposed to take it. **All medicine will be kept with the camp nurse and dispensed when needed.** Have your medicine ready to turn over to the camp nurse at check in time! (Inhalers and other exceptions will be made.)

Are you excited? We hope so! We know that this is a lot of information so if you or your parents have questions, please call us at the numbers below. Our cell phones will also serve as emergency numbers during camp. Know that we are praying for you and that we have been praying for our camp for a very long time. We can't wait to finally meet you!

## What to bring to CAMP...

- Pillow, sheets, and blanket, or sleeping bag (bunks have mattresses)
- Change of clothes and underwear & socks per day
- Extra pair of closed toe shoes (OPEN TOED SHOES – flip flops, sandals, etc. are NOT allowed except in the shower and at the pool... don't want creepy crawlies playing with your toes)
- Hat
- Rainy day outfit ( in case of rain)
- Two towels (one for showering and one for pool)
- Grooming items (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, etc)
- Insect repellent, and sunscreen
- Swimming suit
- Pajamas
- Flashlight
- Bible
- Letters to home kit (complete with envelopes, pen, paper, and stamps)
- Money for offering
- Any medications that are prescribed by your Dr. (these meds must be listed on your registration form & placed in a zip lock bag to be given to the camp nurse)
- Drinking cup or bottle

## Please do NOT bring...

- Fireworks
- Drugs, alcohol or tobacco
- Weapons of any kind, including but not limited to: knives, guns, grenades, nuclear arsenal, shaving cream, water balloons, or anything else that is intended to demoralize another person
- Cell phone, iPods, mp3 players, laptops, computers, video games or any other electronic device
- Large sums of money
- Expensive jewelry
- Pets
- Junk food
