

## Job Description - Praise Band Leader

## Overview:

The praise band leader will be responsible for coordinating and leading the Sunday 9:00am Contemporary Service.

## **Key Performance Objectives:**

- Lead praise band in performing in the Sunday 9:00am Contemporary Service.
- Coordinate praise songs for alignment with service message as applicable.
- Build out praise order of worship and communicate with internal teams for service preparation.
- Conduct praise rehearsals on a weekly schedule.
- Review fellow praise member's attendance schedule and obtain necessary coverage due to an absence.
- Ensure the service starts on time.
- Serve as the point of contact for the music minister to help coordinate congregational unified services.
- Serve as the point of contact for volunteers wishing to join the praise band/perform special music.
- Coordinate special music slots for service each week.
- Coordinate a meeting, preferably monthly, with the worship planning group to coordinate themes, ideas and appropriate music for upcoming services.
- Coordinate and lead a praise band retreat or team-building session at least two times per year.

## Qualifications:

- Commitment to sharing the gospel through contemporary music.
- Preferred ability to read music, or provide necessary music resources (chord charts) that fit every member of the band.
- Experience leading, singing, or playing in Christian Praise Bands.
- Must pass background check.
