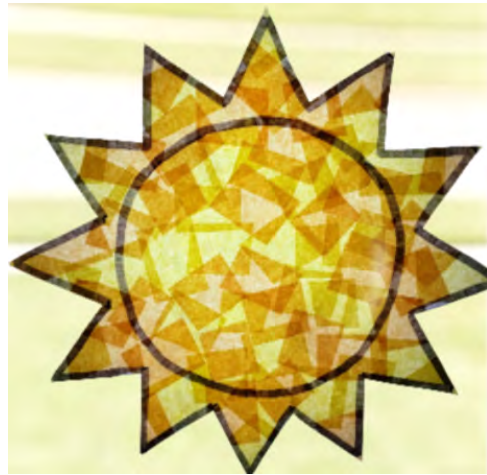

## **SUN SUNCATCHER**

**God said, "Let there be Light."**

### **Sun Suncatcher Supplies Needed:**

Clear Contact Paper  
Tissue Paper (Yellow & Orange)  
Black Sharpie Marker  
Scissors  
Sun Template



Cut two sheets of contact paper the size of your template and remove the backing from one of them. After you've done that, carefully lay it upside down (sticky part up) on top of your printed sun template. The template is used as a guide. I would encourage taping your contact paper to a surface so your sun doesn't move underneath it.

Cut two-inch strips of yellow and orange tissue paper, but you can get as creative as you want. Then start laying your cutout tissue paper. Try not to overload the outer layer with tissue paper though. You'll want to still see the sun's outline under your tissue paper.

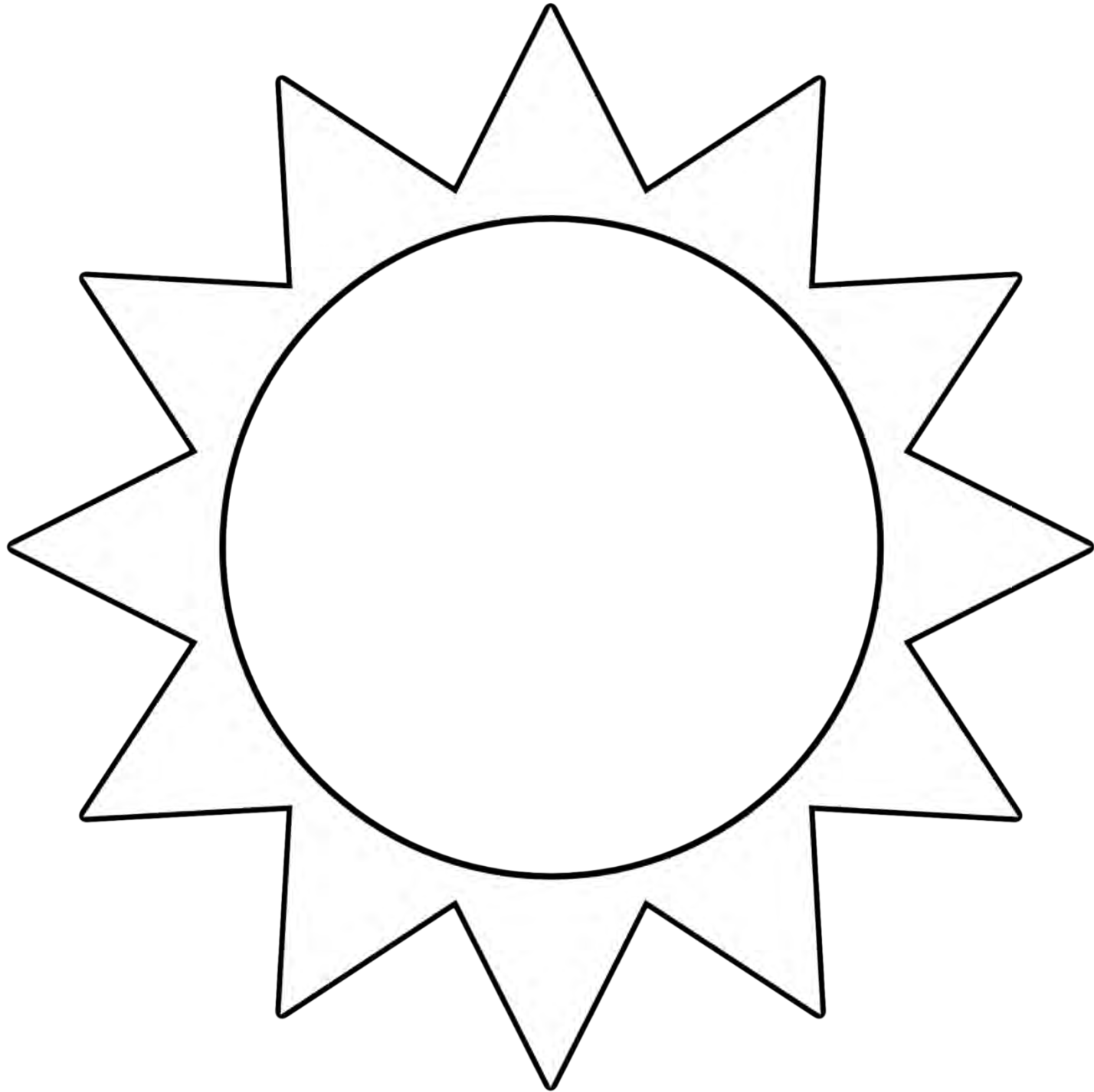
Then peel off the other piece of contact paper. Carefully lay it on top of your sun (sticky side down this time). It is okay if the pieces don't match up exactly. You will be cutting the edges in the following steps.

Once your second layer of contact paper is on, take your large sharpie and trace the sun. Add the words, God said, "Let there be Light" inside the circle.

Now it is time to cut out the sun suncatcher. If you have younger kids, you might want to help them with this step.

Finally, display your new suncatcher sun proudly on your favorite window in the house!

# GOD'S RAINBOW IN THE CLOUDS CRAFT

## Supplies:

- construction or regular paper in the colors of the rainbow
- white construction paper
- wiggle eyes stickers
- scissors
- glue stick
- black marker



You will need one long strip of paper in every color of the rainbow. Have the kids cut the strips (if they are old enough to handle scissors) or cut the strips before. Cut two cloud shapes from the white construction paper.

Glue the colorful strips of paper on one side of the cloud. Glue the other cloud over the strips to cover where the strips were glued. Cut out the scripture at the bottom of the instructions and glue on the back. Read the scripture as you glue it on.

Flip the rainbow cloud over. Stick on two wiggle eye stickers (stickers are super fun!) or draw the eyes. Also draw mouth for a super cute looking face.



# BIRDS OF THE AIR & FISH OF THE SEA

**Every creature has an important role to play in God's Creation.**

Supplies:

- Uncoated paper plate
- Paint for fish- crayons or colored pencils may also be used in place of paint
- Paint for bird- crayons or colored pencils may also be used in place of paint
- Feathers
- Sticky eyes or wiggle eyes
- Black marker
- Scissors
- 2" piece of ribbon
- Glue
- Orange card stock triangles- one small for beak and one large for fin
- Optional: hole punch, ribbon/string for hanging

Instructions:

- Cut the paper plate in half.
- Paint or Color the two plate halves a different color. Let them dry completely.
- Use the other craft materials to make the paper plate pieces look like a fish and a bird. For the bird, glue the wiggle eye and the small beak triangle to the plate. Then glue a small feather to the front of the plate as a wing, and a larger feather to the back as a tail.
- For the fish, glue a wiggle eye. Glue a large triangle on the back. Using a black marker, draw a mouth and gills on the fish.



- Turn both pieces so that the back side is facing up. Glue the 2" piece of ribbon on the back so that it connects the bird and the fish.



- If desired, punch a hole at the top of the bird. String a ribbon through for hanging the craft.

## FOUR SEASONS TREE CRAFT

### Supplies:

- Template of each tree for the four seasons
- Cardboard toilet paper tube
- Glue Stick
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Scissors

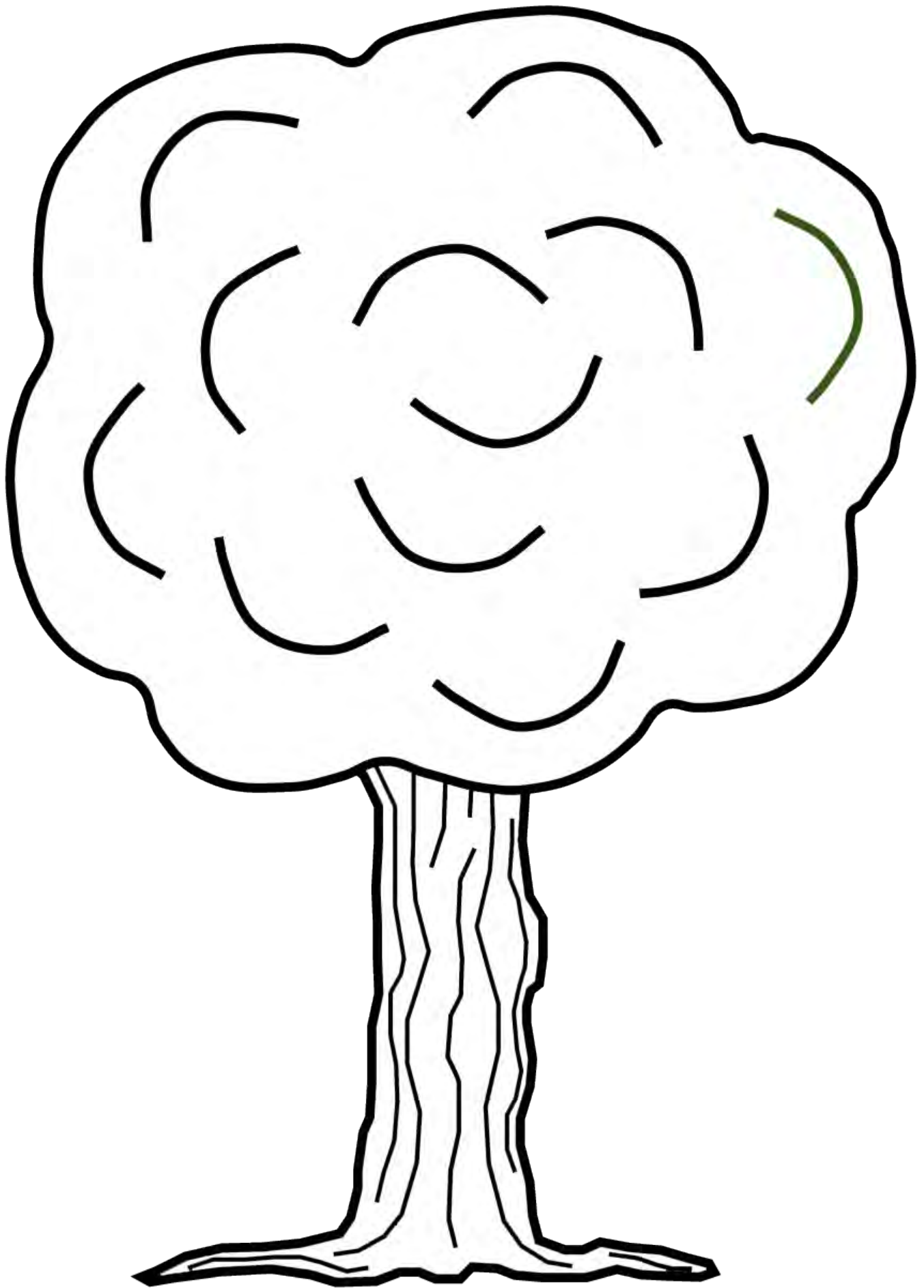


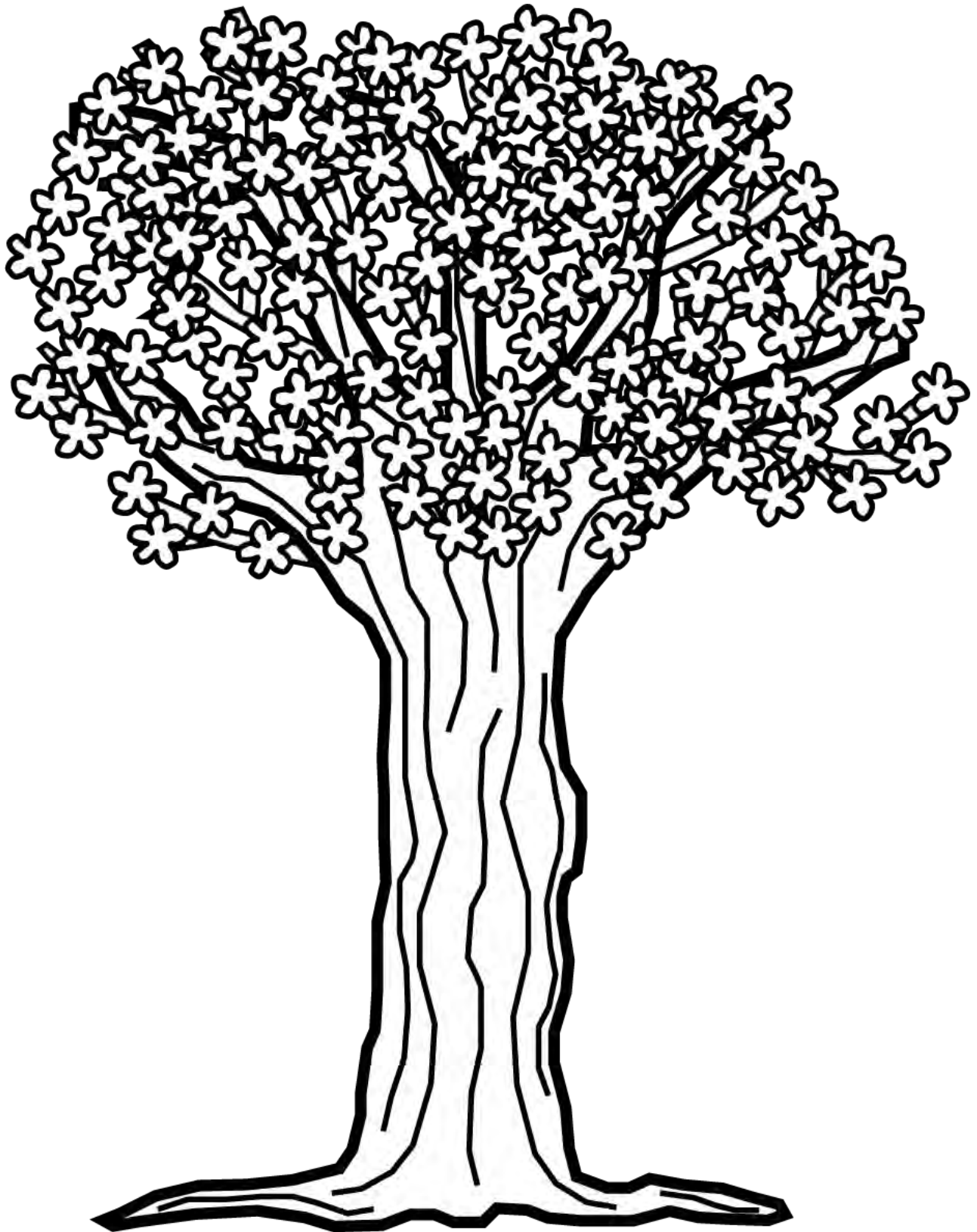
### Instructions:

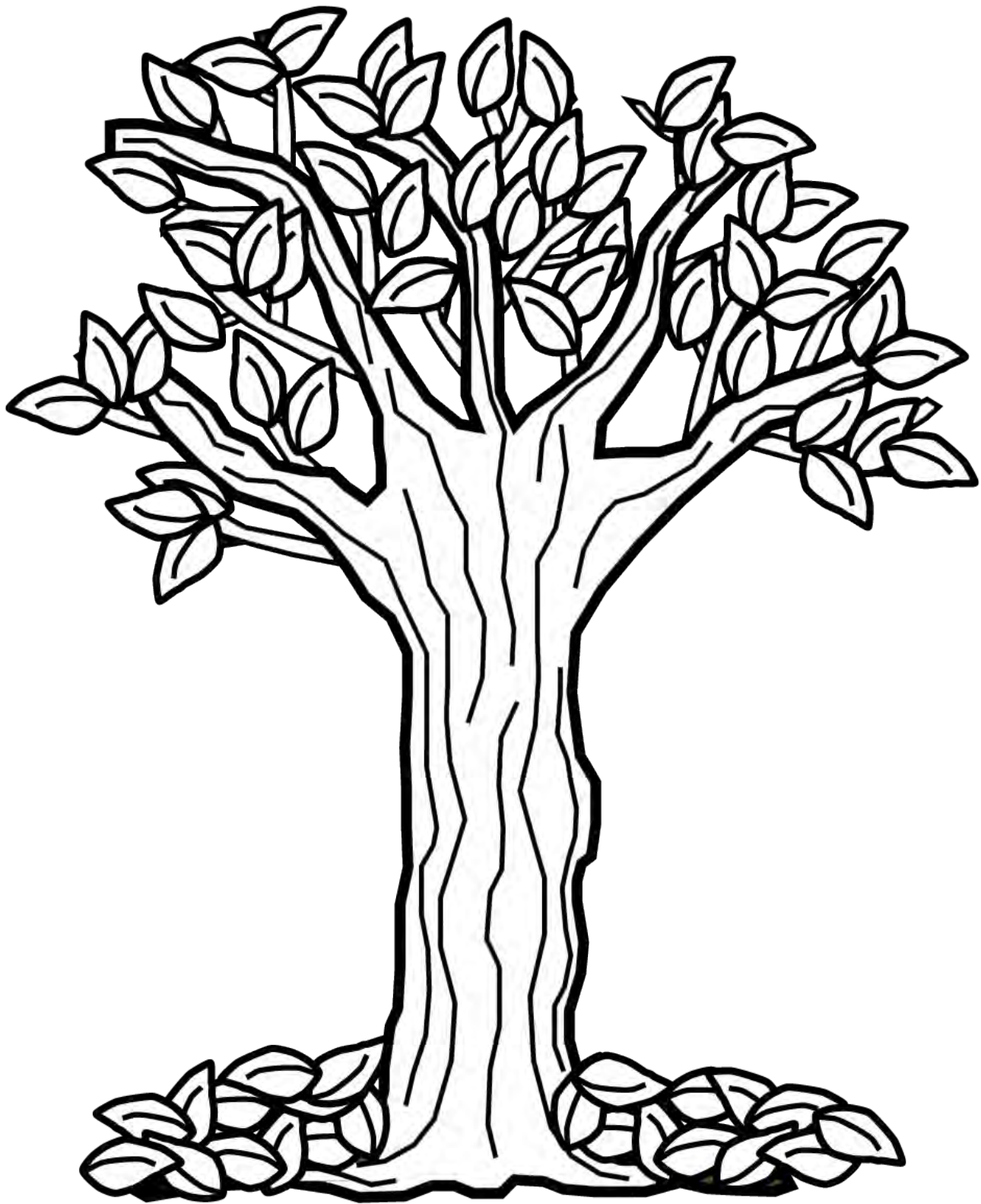
- Color each tree.
- Stack them up and cut them all at the same time so they are all the same size. Bubble cut around them with the summer tree on the top. This one is the largest and will make the rest of them even. You will need to trim the bottom and the side of the trunk off to fit them into the cardboard tube.
- Fold each of the four trees in half, with pictures folded inward.
- To glue them together, you will put two pieces together at a time. Attach half of spring to half of summer, then half of summer to half of the autumn tree, then spring to winter. This will make it a complete circle.
- Cut small slits either in the trees just at the top of the trunk, or in the top of the tube. This helps secure the tree, however, you made need a tiny bit of tape to keep it in place.

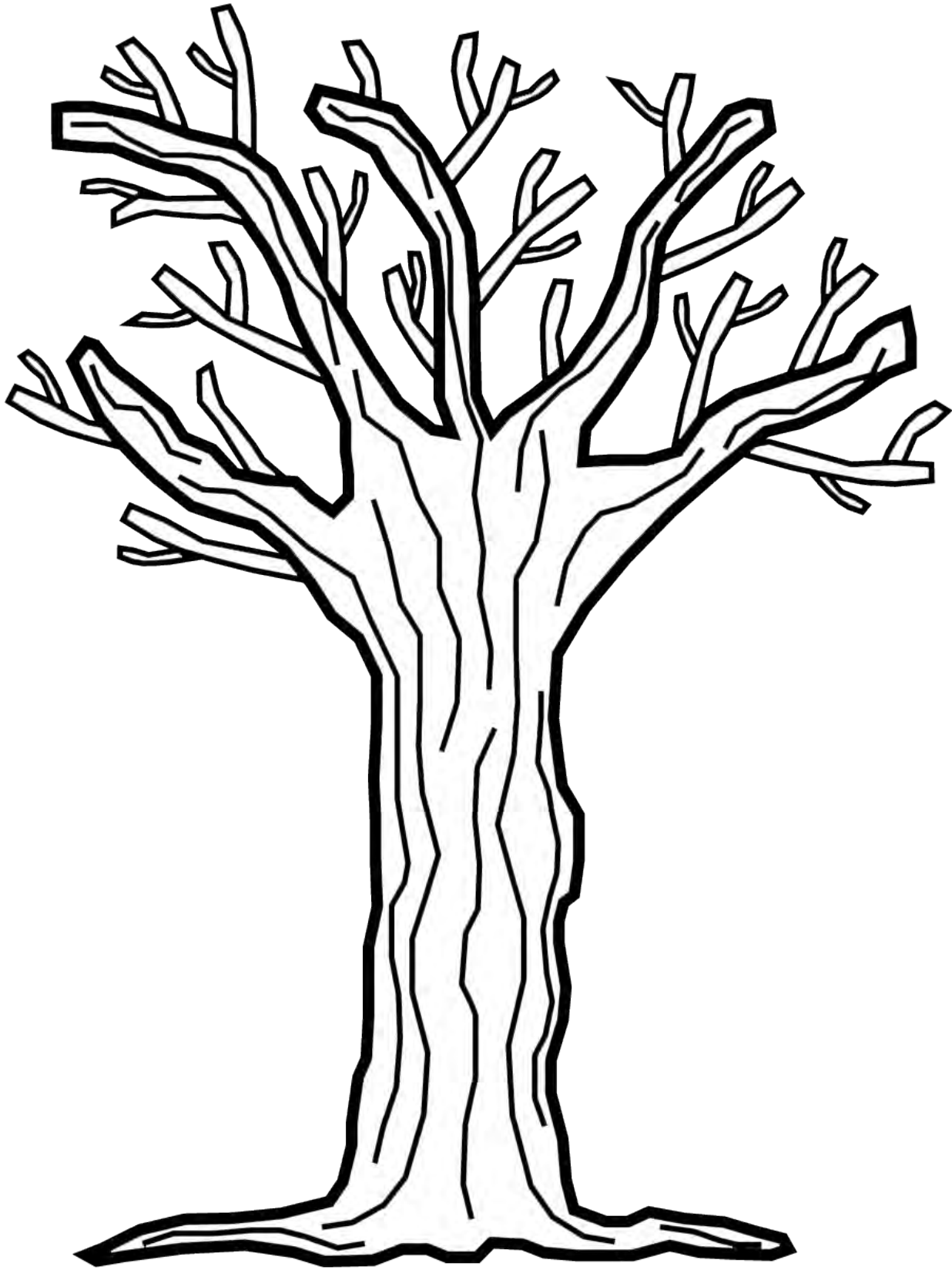

This craft is to teach children that Sabbath begins and ends at sunset. Talk to your children about special things they can do to welcome and end Sabbath.

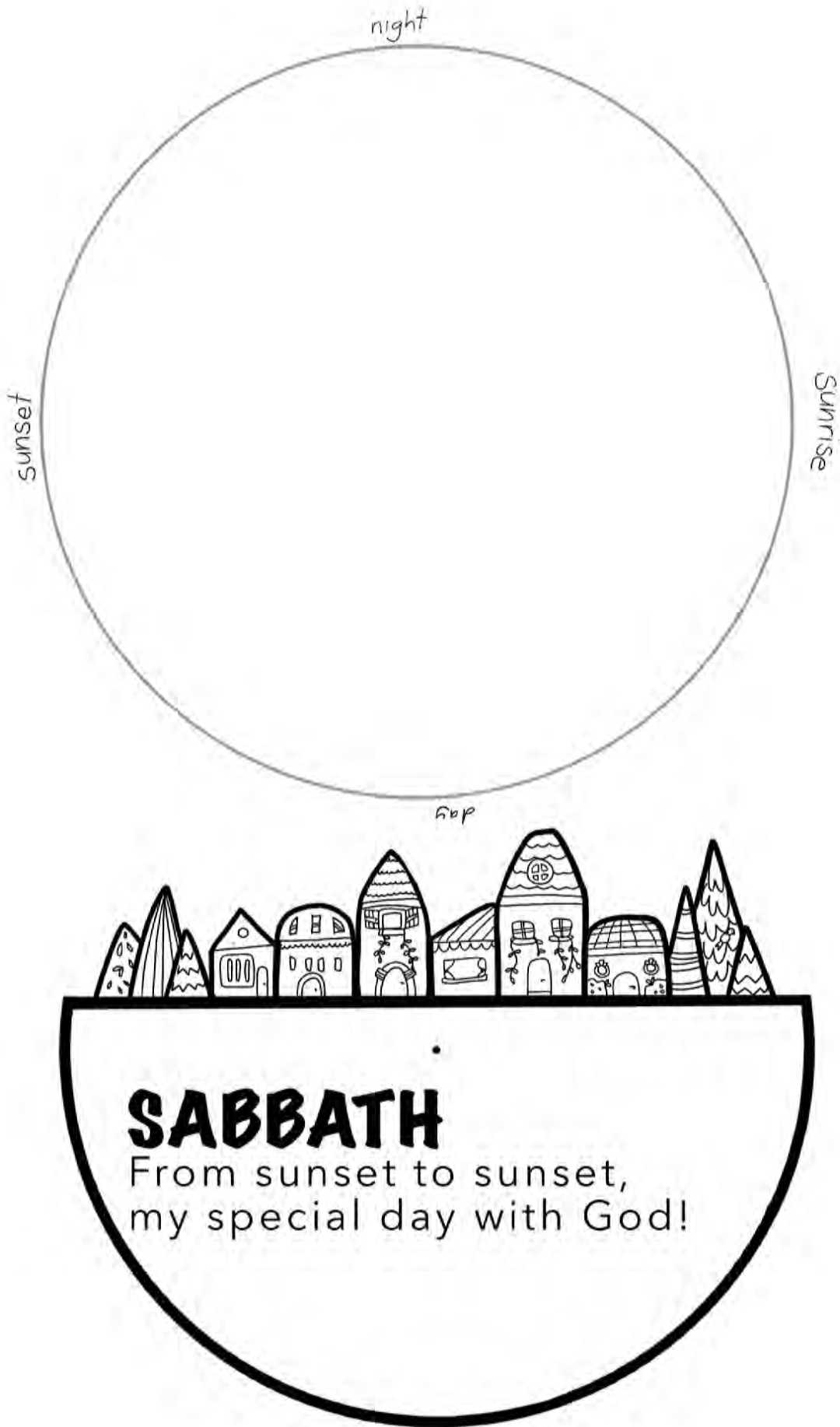
## SUPPLIES:

## INSTRUCTIONS:

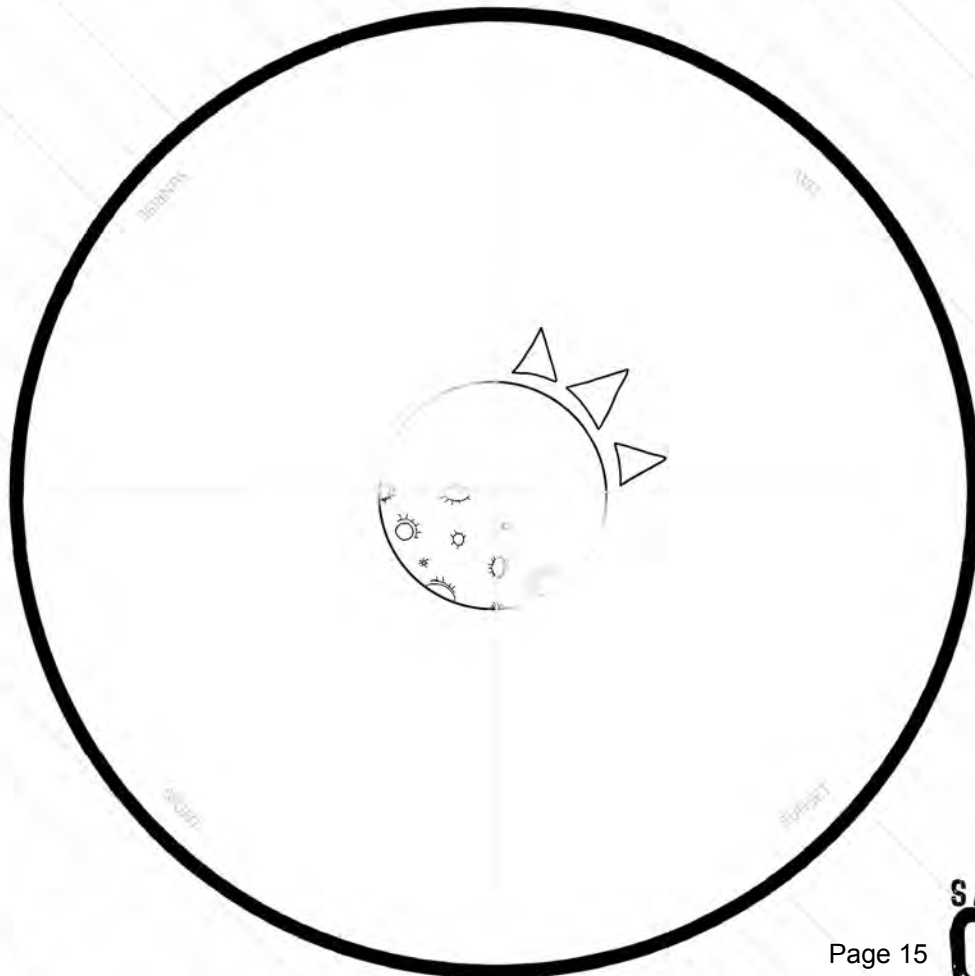
1. Cut out shapes.

3. Attach with round head fasteners/brads/spilt head pins and spin!

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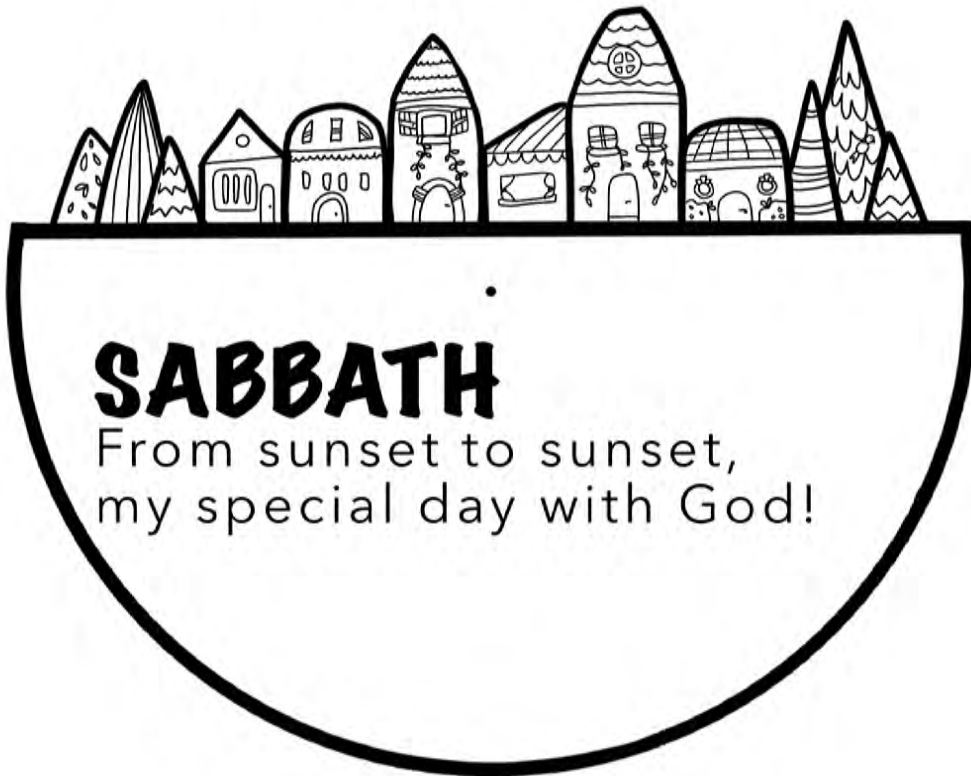




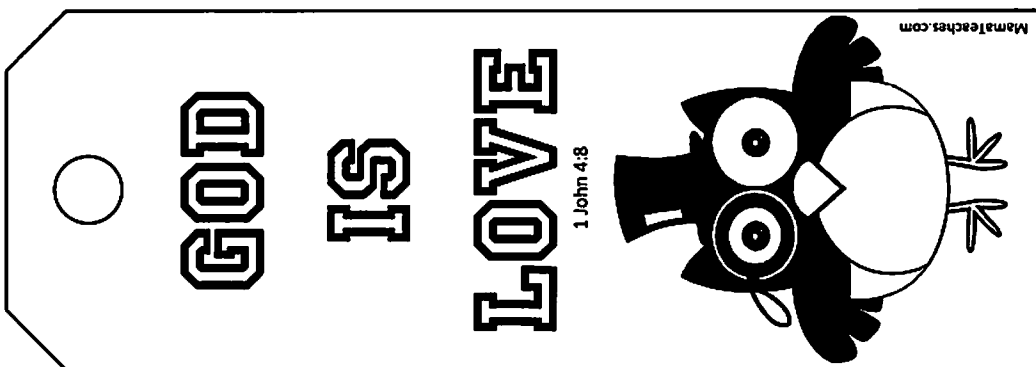
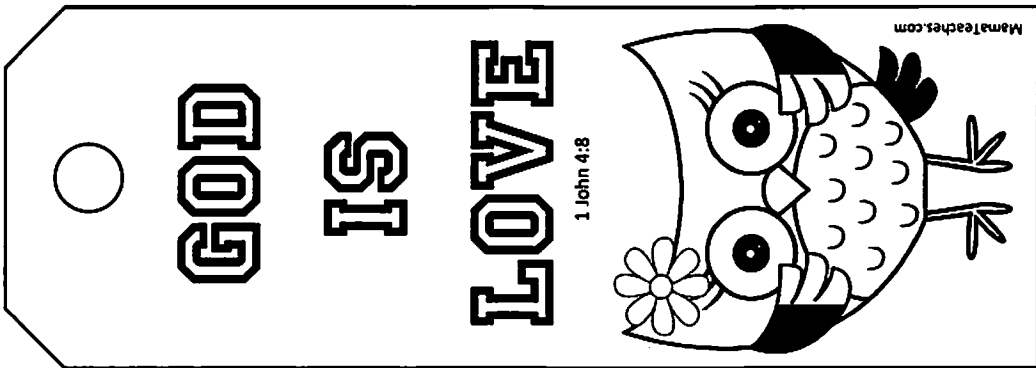
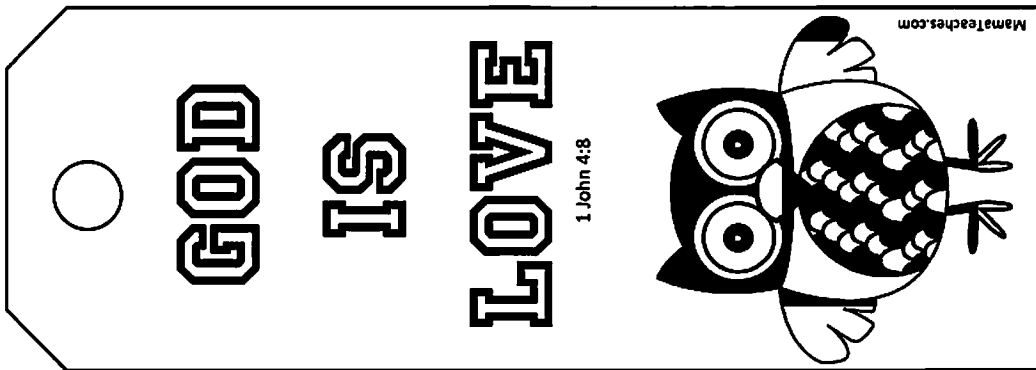
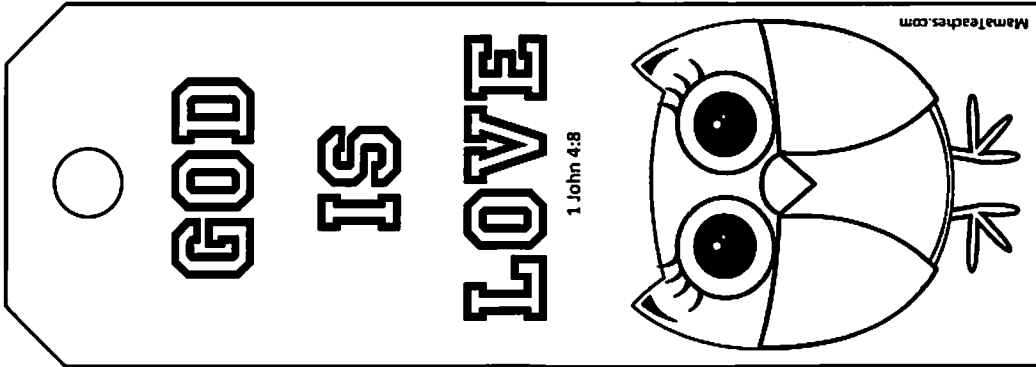
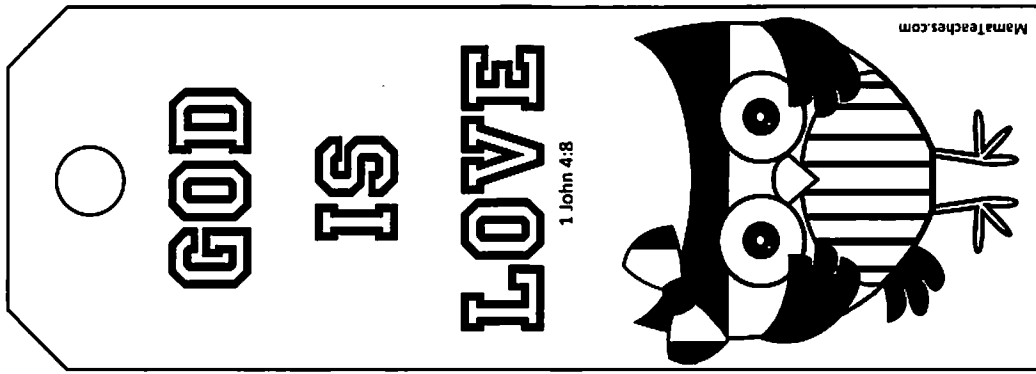
