To the Oklahoma Regional Executive Committee and Regional Board:

At the Oklahoma Regional Assembly on April 20, 2024, the Oklahoma Regional Minister Search Committee was formed and tasked with conducting a denomination-wide search for our next Regional Minister, following the retirement of Rev. Pamela Holt. We began this process with a series of 13 Listening Sessions held across the state, both virtually and inperson, as well as an online survey.

From these sessions eight key priorities emerged, guiding our search, evaluation, and discernment at every stage. We received applications from thirteen candidates serving in nine different Regions. After reviewing and ranking each candidate, we conducted video interviews with four individuals, ultimately inviting two for in-person interviews.

In his 15 years of service as Associate Regional Minister in Oklahoma, Rev. Davison has consistently demonstrated these qualities. And still, we are confident he will have even greater opportunities to utilize his capabilities as Regional Minister.

Some may assume that Rev. Davison's status as an internal candidate made this an easy choice. In fact, the opposite was often true. The Committee was committed to evaluating each candidate fairly and equally, solely on their merits and potential fit for our Region. Ultimately, Rev. Davison emerged as the best candidate for this moment in our shared life.

Rev. Davison has articulated a compelling vision of rejuvenation and rediscovery of our identity —one that aims to foster deeper community and stronger connections among our congregations and clergy. He is theologically grounded, articulate, informed, compassionate, and deeply committed to ministry in Oklahoma. His passion for youth and mentoring will be a valuable asset, particularly as we prepare to welcome a new member to the Regional staff.

Rev. Davison's understanding of the Region's needs aligns closely with what we heard in our listening sessions. He does not shy away from the challenges ahead but faces them with honesty, clarity, and a plan. His demeanor, discernment, approachability, and transparency make him an effective minister to ministers. He is respected across our Region and is well-positioned to build on the relationships he has already developed.

Rev. Davison also brings an admirable breadth of experience to this role: 24 years in Regional Ministry (15 in Oklahoma and 9 in Kentucky), along with 8 years of congregational ministry in six different Regions.

Therefore, we, the Oklahoma Regional Minister Search Committee, enthusiastically recommend the Rev. Michael A. Davison, Jr., for consideration by the Executive Committee, Regional Board, and ultimately, the Regional Assembly as our next Regional Minister.
